#### 4. Presentations:

### 4.1. 2022 Financial Statement - BDO Canada LLP

Mr. Levia and Mr. Wachter of BDO Canada LLP, reviewed the Auditor's Report and the 2022 Audited Financial Statements, comprising of the financial position as of December 31, 2022. The non-financial assets book value is \$67 million cost less amortization, surplus of \$63.4 million. Long-term debt payments for 2023 will be \$175,669. Debt limit has \$2.6 million remaining debt capacity. Accumulated surplus shows operating reserves at \$550,000 and capital reserves at \$1,353,631.

### 5. Reports:

### 5.1. Administration

CAO Thompson presented the Administration Report confirming second Board of Directors Training for June 19, 2023. City of Red Deer wastewater treatment rate is \$1.24 per cubic meter. Due to higher than predicted rates, NRDRWWSC will require a modest rate increase to members starting in 2024. Financials were provided for January/February. Wastewater volumes have increased over the prior year by 2%. Both revenue and expenses are lower than YTD budgeted amounts. Operations is still participating in the University of Calgary wastewater monitoring and a link to the website will be emailed to interested members.


Table 1 - Wastewater volumes (in cubic meters) - January to April

Wastewater volumes have increased over the prior year by 12,149 cubic meters or 1.9%.

### Revenue


As of April, YTD (year to date) actual revenues are lower than YTD budgeted revenues by \$113,037 or 8%. The YTD revenue variances can be attributed to our budgeting allocation which involves evenly distributing the Wastewater treatment revenue budget evenly across all months of the year. Actual YTD Wastewater treatment revenues are lower than YTD budget due to lower volume in winter months.



### **Expenses**

As of April, the YTD actual expenses are lower than YTD budget by \$16,430 or 1%. The YTD water treatment fees are under budget by \$100k which correlates to the YTD revenue variance. Bulk chemicals purchase and annual Insurance payments resulted in a \$83k YTD


deficit variance but are expected to even out over the year. YTD Natural Gas expenses are \$5k over budget due to higher costs in the winter months.



## YTD Surplus/Deficit

As of April 2023, the YTD net deficit is approximately \$96K, largely due to budget timing of expenditures (i.e., Insurance, natural gas, and bulk chemical purchases).

## Notable activities since last report

### Lacombe:

- On June 30, we officially stop collecting a COVID sample for the Province. Only Calgary, Edmonton, Medicine Hat, Lethbridge, Red deer, Fort McMurray, Grande Prairie, Banff, and Jasper will continue sending samples to the Province for analysis.
- SRS water meter is getting replaced, the inner liner failed and is detaching from the meter, and there is no warranty. Operations is looking at options for replacement. The meter is still working but needs to be replaced.

### Blackfalds:

• The goats will be arriving in June to provide weed control at the site.

### OMF:

• The site is working well with plans to chlorinate the water well, drain the wet well for inspection, and begin the weed maintenance plan.

# **Planned Spring maintenance activities:**

• Weed control at all sites and sample the biofilter media at Blackfalds and OMF.
